Prophecy Guidelines in Liberty Church

If you feel that you may have a word of prophesy for the body of Liberty Church during a worship service:

So that everything might be done properly and in order we ask that you to adhere to the following guidelines for giving a public prophesy during a Liberty worship service.

That you have attended a Liberty Church Prophetic Training Class.

That you have been released and charged as a confirmed Prophet by your Co-Pastor.

To always give encouraging and edifying words. Never rebukes.

The proper order to give such a word is as follows:

Go directly to the Co-Pastor who will be sitting on the front row center.

Share the essence of the prophetic word to ascertain if this is the suitable time for this word.

If the Co-Pastor believes that the direction of the service might be going elsewhere, please do not disregard your word but instead of publicly giving it, return to your seat and write it down and after the service give it to your Co-Pastor that each of you may continue to pray God's best direction for your word.

If the Co-Pastor also believes that your word is beneficial to the body at this time and you should give it, then you can expect the following:

The Co-Pastor will walk you to the front of the Sanctuary to bring the word to the church.

So that your word can be clearly heard the Co-Pastor will hold the microphone for you.

And as always, Please remember to keep the prophecies short, positive and encouraging.
